Director of Finance, Ms. Sara Harley shared that the legal advertisement ran in the M&I newspaper on Tuesday, August 14 and Tuesday, August 21, 2018 per KRS 160.470 (7)(b).

Adoption of rates is as follows: 70.7 cents per \$100 valuation rate for real and personal property, and 49.0 cents per \$100 for motor vehicles. This also includes a permissive tax of 3% on utilities and the taxability of aircraft and watercraft.

#68 12.5. Consider Approval of the 2018-19 Tax Rates

KRS 132.0225 requires Districts adopt tax rates within 45 days after the receipt of a certified assessment for the current fiscal year. The Board must levy tax rates and determine revenues and expenditures to submit to the Kentucky Department of Education.

Adoption of rates is as follows: 70.7 cents per \$100 valuation rate for real and personal property, and 49.0 cents per \$100 for motor vehicles. This also includes a permissive tax of 3% on utilities and the taxability of aircraft and watercraft.

Considering historical uncollectible tax revenue, rates are expected to generate \$1,568,310 that will be used to offset additional budgetary expenses in 2018-19. Additionally, the building fund should expect a revenue increase in local tax revenue of \$246,549 which will be used for debt service including new debt for construction.
