PRESENTER BIOS



Dr. Patricia O'Gorman, Ph.D. is an internationally-recognized public speaker who was one of the first researchers in children of alcoholics in the early 1970's, documenting the impact of alcoholism and sobriety on adolescent development. In 1974, Patricia created the Department of Prevention and Education for the National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependence (NCADD). She is noted for her work on women, children of alcoholics, and trauma in the child welfare, mental health, and substance abuse systems.



Wendy Wade, PhD, LPCC and CADC 1, is Professor and Core Faculty member in the Master's in Counseling Program at Palo Alto University teaching the Substance Abuse Course, among others. She has facilitated specialized support groups for children of addicted parents at both Kids Are Special in the 1980s and as Coordinator of the Betty Ford Center Children's Program more recently. She has provided many varied trainings, spoken at conferences, and provided workshops on addiction itself as well as its effects on children and families.
