

Parent Involvement Partnership

Heritage Park High School Parent Involvement Partnership

1. Upon admission, parents, students and an administrator sign a School-Parent Compact agreeing to abide by the guiding principles of Heritage Park High School.
2. Parents receive notice that they are welcome in our building and encouraged to visit our school, or communicate with staff at their convenience by email or phone calls. Interpreters are available for parents with limited English proficiency or with disabilities if scheduled in advance.
3. Parents will be invited to attend the Welcome Back Picnic, Veteran's Day Program, Phoenix Futures Fair, Prom Preview, Senior Awards Breakfast and Graduation activities.
4. Parents will be given notice of Youth Service Center Advisory Board meetings for their input into programs, activities and events offered to our students. Parents will also be invited to plan, review and improve the School-Parent Compact and the Parent Involvement Policy.
5. Parents will be invited to attend and evaluate all activities offered to students and their families.
6. Parents will be considered partners in their child's education by agreeing to make sure their child is well fed, rested and at school every day. Teacher and school staff will provide a high quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables students to meet Kentucky's performance standards.
7. Parents will be invited for Parent-Teacher meetings in the spring and fall for all students, Prom Preview, Senior Breakfast and Graduation ceremonies in the spring and other events as they arise.
8. Parents will be kept informed of their child's academic performance through grade reports which are available on the student and parent portals of Infinite Campus each grading period.
9. Teachers will mail individual and student performance notes, email parents or call home to communicate with the parents periodically during the course of each semester as updates to class performance.
