

What is the DCPS Parent/Student Portal?

The parent/student portal website will allow users to have “real-time” access to information related to your household. With one unique login, parents will be able to see information about all children in one view. Students will see information unique to them. DCPS will display the following data on the portal site: Attendance, Report Cards, Progress Reports, Contact Information, Special Education Forms, Assessment Information, Health Information, Student To-Do List, Family Calendar, and Current Grading.

With any live Internet browser, simply go to <http://portal.dcps.org>

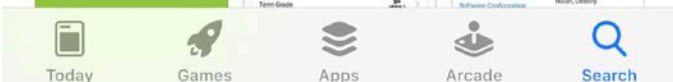
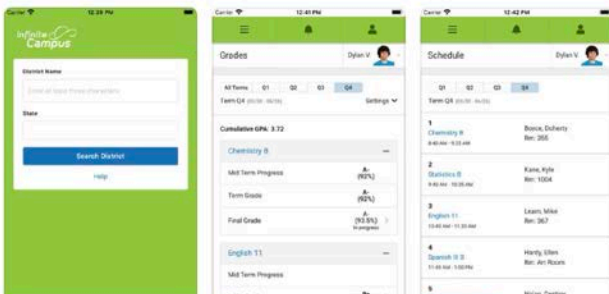
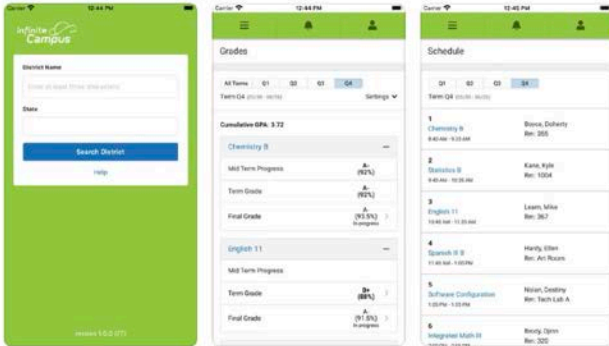
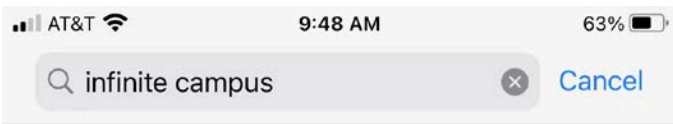
How do I get a login?
