## DCPS hosting Governor's Cup events

Several schools in the Daviess County Public Schools are hosting district and regional Governor's Cup competitions for students in grades 4 and 5, and all DCPS elementary schools are participating. Governor's Cup features eight events, including written assessments in areas of composition, science, social studies, language arts, arts and humanities, and mathematics. In addition, Future Problem Solving (FPS) involves teams of four students who work collaboratively. The academic events are sponsored by the Kentucky Association for Academic Competition.

The Quick Recall event is the only event open to the public. This exciting and fast-paced event is perfect for our media partners to share with readers/viewers/listeners! Quick Recall is scheduled to begin at 10:45 a.m. Saturday, Feb. 9, at Country Heights Elementary School, 4961 Kentucky 54.

Audubon Elementary School is hosting the District 21 Governor's Cup competition on Feb. 5 for FPS/Composition, and Feb. 9 for Written Assessment/Quick Recall. The school is located at 300 Worthington Road. In addition to the host school, participating schools are Sorgho, West Louisville, Cravens and Foust elementary schools. Tamarack Elementary School is hosting the District 22 Governor's Cup competition on Feb. 5 for FPS/Composition, and Feb. 9 for Written Assessment/Quick Recall.
