Technical courses are designed for students who are interested in exploring career options that include automotive technology, diesel mechanics, computer information technology, welding, nursing assistants, and many more. Your high school College and Career Readiness Coach can provide information about available programs. Most programs are half-day courses located on the Owensboro Community and Technical College campus.

- Technical courses are open to students in grades 11 and 12.
- Students are required to meet ACT benchmarks and be in good standing at their high school to be eligible for participation in the technical course program.
- Dual credit is provided by Owensboro Community and Technical College.
- Tuition is based on dual credit rate.
- Scholarships are available.
