Graduation Prerequisites*

Reading and Math Required

Reading-Meet One of the Following

- Proficient or Higher, Grade 8 State-Required Reading Assessment
- Score At or Above Minimum Criteria, Grade 10 State-Required Reading Assessment
- Approved Collection of Evidence in Reading

Math-Meet One of the Following

- Proficient or Higher, Grade 8 State-Required Math Assessment
- Score At or Above Minimum Criteria, Grade 10 State-Required Math Assessment
- Approved Collection of Evidence in Math

Graduation Qualifiers

Meet One of the Following

- Complete Precollege Curriculum as Determined by CPE
- Achieve CPE Benchmarks on College Placement Exam in One Section
- Complete 3 Postsecondary Credit Hours in KDE Approved Dual Credit Course with Grade of C or Higher
- Complete 1 AP Course with Exam Score of 3 or Higher
- Obtain Industry Certificate
- Complete 4 Credits in KDE Career Pathway
- 500 Hours of KDE Approved Work Experience
- 2 Years of KDE Approved Apprenticeship Program

- Take 3 AP Exams--No Required Score
